Phase III of Governor Walz Stay Safe Minnesota order starts today, June 10th. “Churches, hair salons and indoor bars and restaurants can serve up to 50% of their capacities, while fitness centers, bowling alleys and movie theaters can serve 25% of their capacities as they reopen for the first time in more than two months.”

Unfortunately, the Governor has not yet released any more information regarding Senior Housing. We still are waiting on guidance from Minnesota Department of Health on a timeline for reopening our doors to visitors, hair dressers, and other guests.

Please know there can be false representations in the media regarding long term care settings. A weekend article in the StarTribune was updated because of inaccurate data. We are on daily email updates from the health department and legislators to stay informed.
