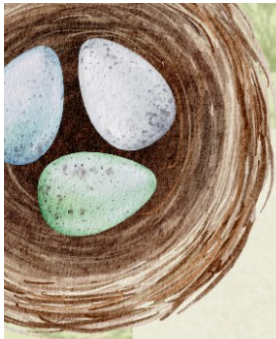

- 1:45 p.m.: Initial tornado drill, intended for businesses, schools, and organizations.
- 6:45 p.m.: Second tornado drill, intended for families and second-shift workers.

What should you do?

- Stay Calm
- Close all windows and blinds
- Listen to the staff's instructions for sheltering in place
- You can shelter in you bathrooms or we move to the corporate hallway, away from windows

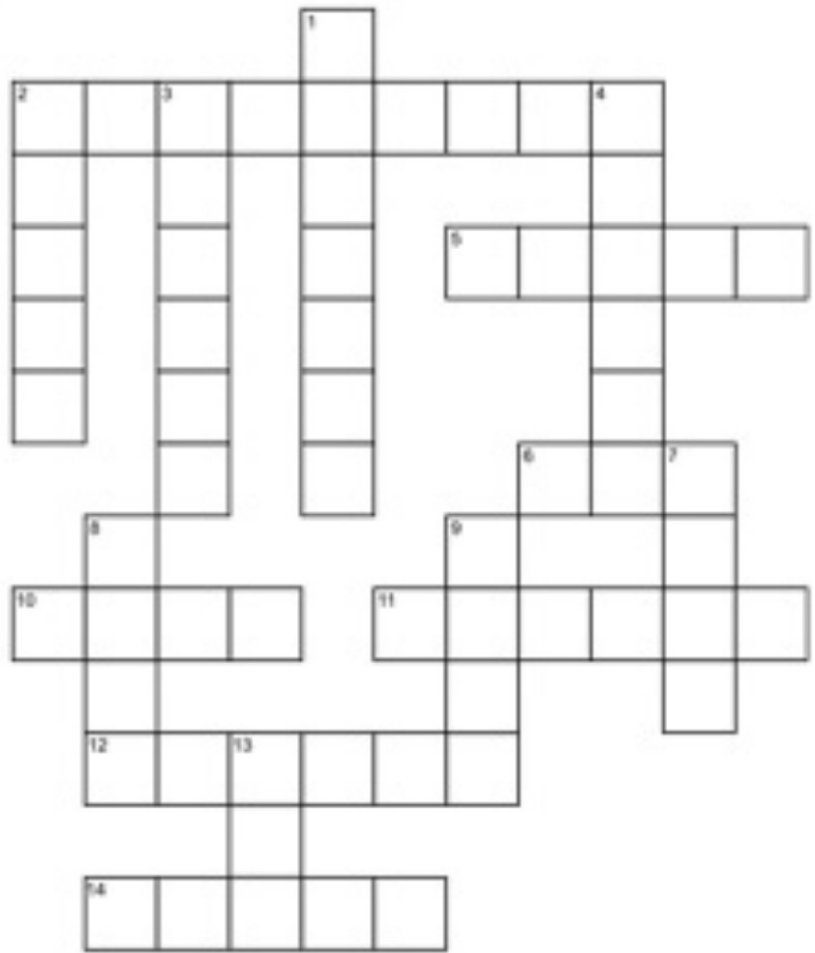
