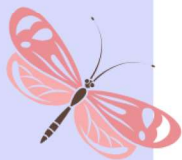

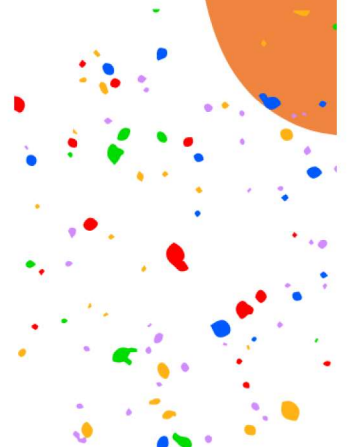
Coloring can ease the mind and stimulate creativity. We will work to get a jumbo coloring piece done together!
