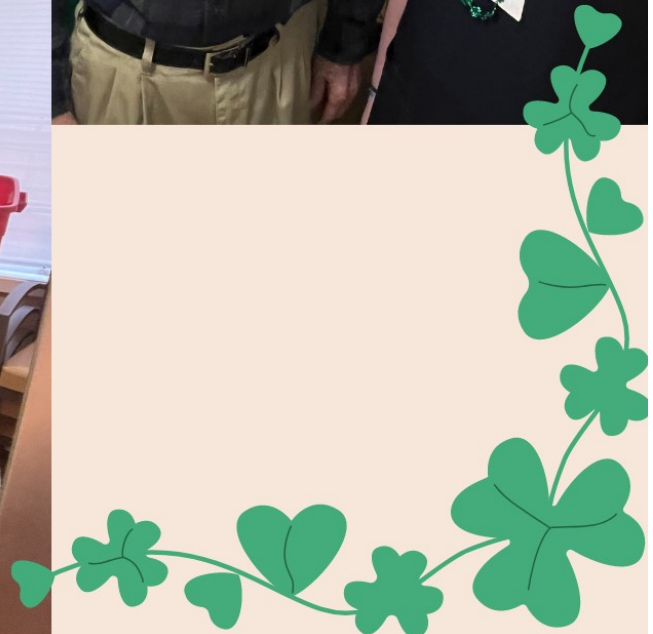

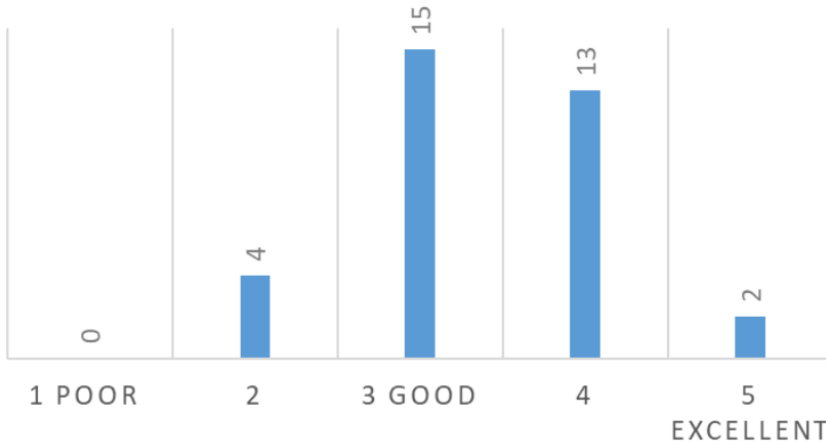
Look Back At March

FOOD QUALITY RATING



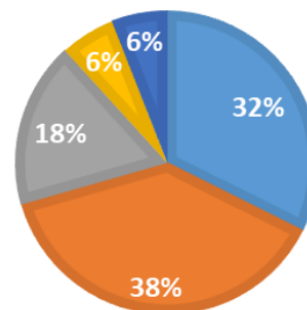
- We now are wondering what food items are not meeting the 4 and 5 level of satisfaction?

We will be asking these questions at the next resident forum on 4/5/2023!

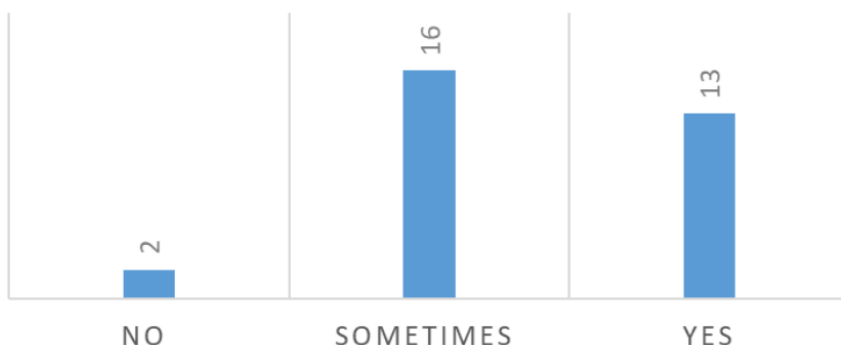
- We will continue to utilize the Monthly Newsletter and Calendar as those are preferred the most!
