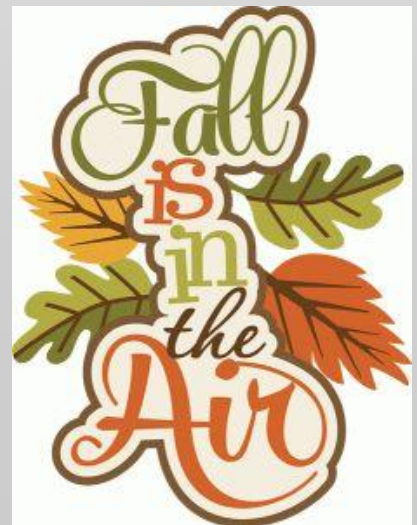

COVID-19 UPDATE

On 9/13/2021 we had two residents exposed to a positive COVID-19 case by a contracted staff member. We found out on 9/15/21 and immediately postponed visitations until testing was complete. We are very thankful that everyone came back negative and we were able to resume visitations.

COVID -19 BOOSTER

We are in contact with our partnering pharmacy and will keep you updated with the process and information regarding the vaccine booster when we know more.

10/1/2021 Visit Guidelines

- You must screen at the front desk, even if visiting outside. We have an electronic Fahrenheit machine to get you screened and will print you a badge when complete.
- Masks must be worn when in Arbor Terrace. You may only remove it when in a closed room with all vaccinated individuals. Masks must stay on in hallways, common areas, or around residents.
- Visits are to occur during the hours of 8am – 6pm.
- We will continue to use the website for reservations. An area has been added for you to enter in your estimated arrival time for the date and timeframe you choose to schedule a visit. (not mandatory but highly recommended)

Once the reservation is approved, the visitor will receive a confirmation email. A confirmation email could take up to 24 hours to receive. 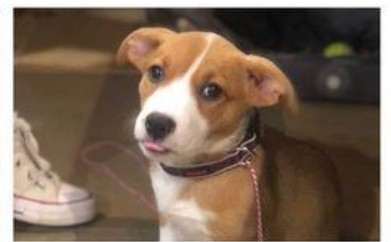
