Hello Everyone,

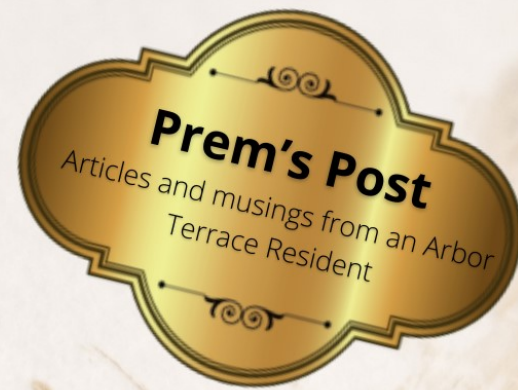

1880s

the average work day was
12 hours, but could often reach
upwards of 18 hours



THE HISTORY OF LABOR DAY

1882

Labor Day got its beginnings when
the Central Labor Union in New York
called for a "monster labor festival"
that included a parade and picnic

1887

Oregon became the first state to
make Labor Day an official holiday



1933

the eight-hour day
became federal law

1950s

the eight-hour day finally
became standard in the U.S.

1894

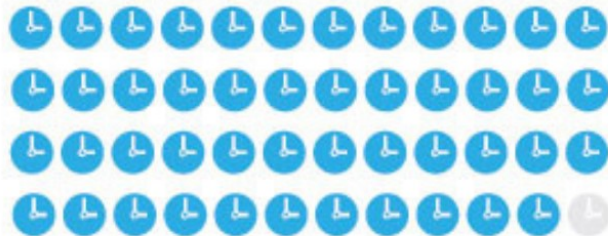
Congress made Labor Day
