Hello Everyone,

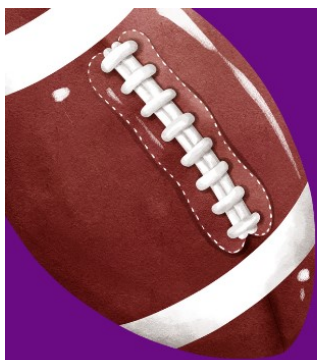
